Selection Criteria

- High school sophomore or junior
- Must have demonstrated leadership or leadership potential
- Actively involved in school or community
- Interested in American history and/or government. *Students taking US History or AP US History may have an advantage*
- Desired - Minimum GPA of 3.0 (4 point system)
- In top 50% of class

Additional Information for Guidance Counselors, Award Committees, JROTC Instructors, and Organizations

- **Only two applicants per school.** *Exception may be made for last minute "alternates" from local schools.*
 - **If sending two students**, try to send one male and one female to help balance the numbers.
 - **Schools with JROTC programs** – Only one should be a JROTC cadet to support the Foundation's sanctioning by the National Association of Secondary School Principals.
- **ALTERNATES** – When asked by AIFCV, please select a sophomore student as an Alternate and submit their application to the Foundation.
- **Any Free Tuition/Scholarships provided through the Foundation may be withdrawn** if ALL REQUIRED application forms are not filled out completely and returned to the Foundation by the filing deadline.
- **Entire application** can be faxed to 757-867-9068.
- **Do not select students** if there is a possibility of the student's sports season conflicts with the Conference dates – please consider district, regional, and state playoffs.
